

Globes in the Collection

Indo-Persian celestial Globe, 17th-century Inventory No. 37195

This is probably an Indo-Persian celestial globe made in the 17th Century out of brass. It is not signed or dated. The globe is marked only with the usual great circles, some of which are named, and with the names of the twelve Zodiacal divisions of the ecliptic. The meridian circle and the stand are modern.
